## JANUARY 3<sup>RD</sup> AND 4<sup>TH</sup>

All elementary students, including those that attend ChurchillCSD and Oasis Academy do not have school on Monday & Tuesday, January 3<sup>rd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> for Teacher Workday/Professional Development. This day may be added to at the daily drop-in rate. Students who participate in CARE who attend both full days will be charged an additional \$25 for the week (normally \$40/week for regular schedule).

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### PAYMENTS & REGISTRATION

- Registration is on a first come, first served basis.  
(Registration takes place at the Churchill County Parks & Recreation Office at 325 Sheckler Road between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m.)
- Pre-registration is required for each week/day
- Winter Fun Staff will not accept payment. Please plan accordingly to ensure payment is made prior to dropping off children each day.

### CAMP INFORMATION

- Drop-Off and Pick-Up is at the Cottonwood Building (223 Sheckler Road) unless otherwise stated
  - Parent/Legal Guardian must sign camper in and out every day!
  - There will be a late charge accrued for campers who are not picked up by 6:00 p.m. daily.
  - Snacks are served daily at 10:00 a.m. and 3:30 p.m.

  - Swimsuit & Towel (Mondays and Wednesdays)
  - Bag Lunch
  - We are unable to Refrigerate or Heat Lunches
    - No Glass Containers
    - Water Bottle
  - Spending money if appropriate (will be announced in advance)
  - Bring a good attitude each day for some Winter Fun!!!
