



The Commission on Mineral Resources, Division of Minerals has issued to Enel Salt Wells, LLC, 1755 East Plumb Lane, Suite 155, Reno, NV 89502 the following permits:

Permit 727, API Number 27-001-90344 has been assigned to Industrial Production Well 14-25, located in the SW/4 NWE/4 of Section 25.

Permit 728, API Number 27-001-90345 has been assigned to Industrial Production Well 86-26, located in the NE/4 SE/4 of Section 26.

Permit 729, API Number 27-001-90346 has been assigned to Industrial Production Well 46-35, located in the NW/4 SE/4 of Section 35.

Permit 730, API Number 27-001-90347 has been assigned to Industrial Production Well 61-35, located in the NW/4 NE/4 of Section 35.

Permit 731, API Number 27-001-90348 has been assigned to Industrial Production Well 67-35, located in the SW/4 SE/4 of Section 35.

These wells will be used for production support for a binary geothermal power plant to be built within the boundaries of the project area permit, Permit 698, located in T17N, R30E, in Churchill County, Nevada. The projected depth of the production wells will be between 750' to 1500'.

Permit 725, API Number 27-001-90342 has been assigned to Industrial Injection Well 45-23, located in the NE/4 SW/4 of Section 23.

Permit 726, API Number 27-001-90343 has been assigned to Industrial Injection Well 56-23, located in the NW/4 SE/4 of Section 23.

Permit 732, API Number 27-001-90349 has been assigned to Industrial Injection Well 52-36, located in the NW/4 NE/4 of Section 36.

Permit 733, API Number 27-001-90350 has been assigned to Industrial Injection Well 54-36, located in the SE/4 NE/4 of Section 36.

Permit 734, API Number 27-001-90351 has been assigned to Industrial Injection Well 63-36, located in the SW/4 NE/4 of Section 36.

Permit 735, API Number 27-001-90352 has been assigned to Industrial Injection Well 65-36, located in the SW/4 SE/4 of Section 36.

These wells will be used for injection support for a binary geothermal power plant to be built within the boundaries of the project area permit, Permit 698, located in T17N, R30E, in Churchill County, Nevada. The projected depth of the injection wells will be approximately 1500'.

NOTE Ormat Nevada has made a well number correction to Permit 665. The well was originally permitted as the 42-26 and has now been corrected to the number **31-26**.
