Discussion: The Nevada Division of Environmental Protection (NDEP) has received and reviewed the Groundwater Monitoring Report for the Fourth Quarter of 2007 concerning Time Oil Store on South Taylor Street in Fallon, Nevada. During the quarter, seven groundwater monitoring wells, one observation well, two groundwater extraction wells and one domestic well were sampled for benzene, toluene, ethyl benzene, xylene and MTBE. Only one well OW-1 had contamination above Nevada State Action Levels. There were no contaminants found in the off site domestic drinking water well. The completion of the remediation system installation is expected by mid February 2008. NDEP concurs with this report and recommendation.

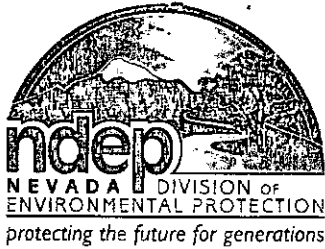

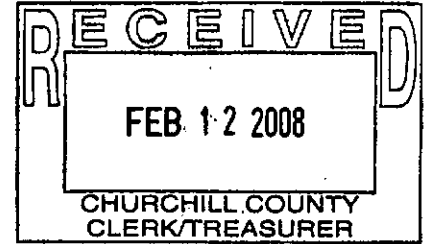

The Nevada Division of Environmental Protection (NDEP) received your, Groundwater Monitoring Report 4th Quarter 2007, Time Oil Store #6-108, dated February 2008, prepared on your behalf by McGinley & Associates.

During the quarter seven groundwater monitoring wells, one observation well, two groundwater extraction wells and one domestic well were sampled for benzene, toluene, ethyl benzene, xylene and MTBE. Only one well OW-1 had contaminants above Nevada State Action Levels. There were no contaminants found in the off site domestic drinking water well.

The completion of the remediation system installation is expected by mid February 2008.
