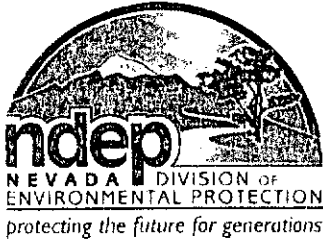

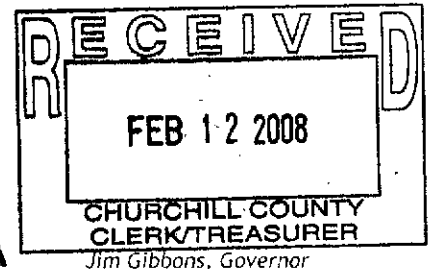

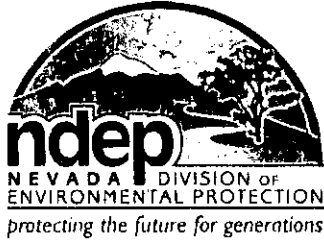

Nevada Division of Environmental Protection Bureau of Water Quality Planning

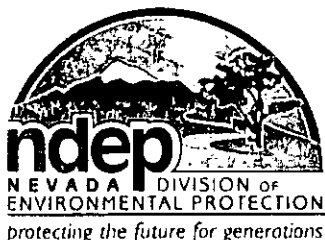
